


Accessing Skype

Skype allows you to talk over the Internet to anyone in the world for free.

1. Go to <http://skype.com/download>
2. Most computer operating systems are automatically recognized
If your operating system is not recognized, you can choose the correct Skype version on the right hand side of the page under "Skype is also available for."
3. Click on the green "Download now" button.
4. Follow the directions to download and run the Setup Wizard.
5. Launch Skype.
6. Create your account.
