



CTY Testing Pilot for Students in Grades 2-12

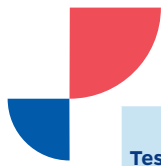


The Johns Hopkins Center for Talented Youth is accepting students' scores from a variety of state and national norm tests that students may have already taken at school or for other academic purposes, for a testing pilot study running February 1, 2021-June 30, 2022.

Students in grades 2-12 who have scored in the 98th percentile or higher—or two or more grade levels above their current grade level—on one of the following tests taken after July 1, 2017, may submit their scores to gain eligibility for CTY programs. Submitted score reports must contain the student name and test date in order to be processed. No Talent Search application is needed. Score exceptions will not be granted.

*For tests that have both grade and age percentile scores, only grade percentiles are considered for eligibility.

Grade Level Equivalence Scores

GLE Difference (GLE score minus grade at time of testing)*	Eligibility
< 2	None
>= 2	CTY-Level

*For example, if a student was in grade 7 at the time of testing and scored a GLE of 8.9, then the GLE Difference is 1.9 (8.9-7).
